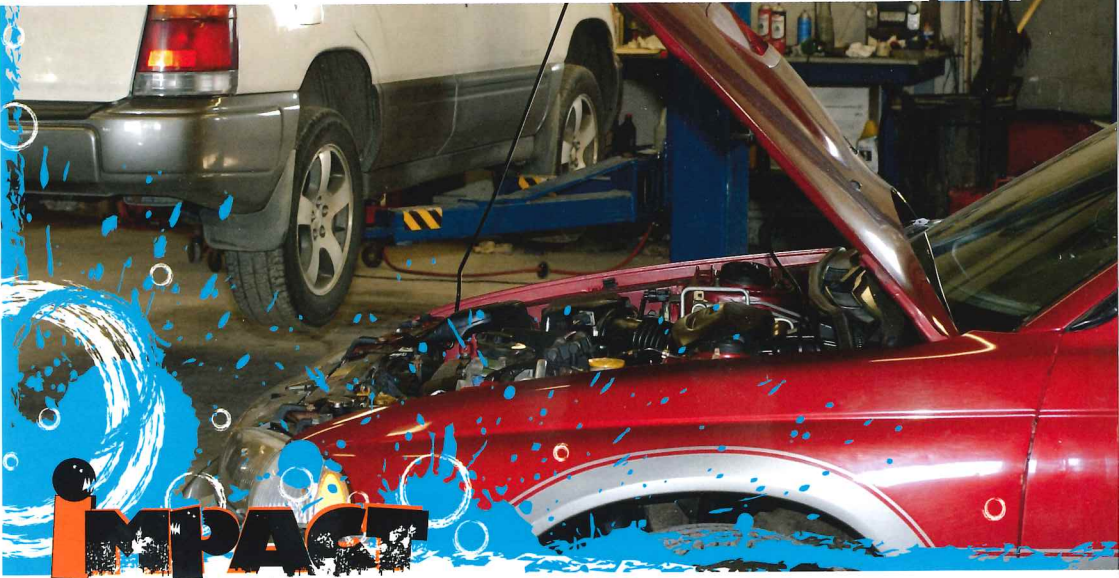


## Study Programmes: Level 1 Diploma Motor Vehicle Maintenance
